Upper Wapsipinicon WMA Phase 4 Watershed Improvements UW-BID-004 Buchanan County, Iowa Shive-Hattery Project No. 4182270

The general nature of the improvement consists of three individual project locations where conservation practices (wetlands) will be constructed in accordance with Iowa NRCS Standard Specifications and the project special specifications. The projects will be constructed on municipal land within the Upper Wapsipinicon River Watershed located in Delaware County, Iowa as part of the Iowa Watershed Approach. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to: mobilization, site preparation, topsoiling, core trench excavation, embankment construction, sheet pile weir procurement and installation, pipe procurement and installations, rock rip-rap procurement and installation, grouting of rip rap, tile investigation, removal, and installation and seeding, mulching and fertilizing. All three projects will be awarded to a single lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The engineer's opinion of probable cost is \$329,000.

Each bidder shall accompany its bid with bid security, as security that the successful bidder will enter into a contract for the work bid upon and will furnish after the award of contract a corporate surety bond, in a form acceptable to the Jurisdiction, for the faithful performance of the contract, in an amount equal to 100% of the amount of the contract. The bid security must be in the minimum amount of 5% of the total bid. Bid security shall be in the form of a cashier's check or a certified check, drawn on an FDIC insured bank in lowa or drawn on an FDIC insured bank chartered under the laws of the United States; or a certified share draft drawn on a credit union in lowa or chartered under the laws of the United States; or a bid bond executed by a corporation authorized to contract as a surety in lowa or satisfactory to the Jurisdiction. The bid bond must be submitted on the enclosed Bid Bond form as no other bid bond forms are acceptable. All signatures on the bid bond must be original signatures in ink; facsimile (fax) of any signature or use of an electronic signature on the bid bond is not acceptable. Bid security other than said bid bond shall be made payable to Howard County. "Miscellaneous Bank Checks," and personal checks, as well as "Money Orders" and "Traveler's Checks" issued by persons, firms, or corporations licensed under Chapter 533C of the lowa Code, are not acceptable bid security.

By virtue of statutory authority, preference will be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the State of Iowa, and to Iowa domestic labor, to the extent lawfully required under Iowa statutes.
