The general nature of the improvement consists of four individual project locations where a pond, wetland, or county road project will be constructed on agricultural and municipal county right of way within the Upper Wapsipinicon River Watershed located in Buchanan County, Iowa. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to: mobilization, site preparation, topsoiling, core trench excavation, embankment construction, gravel road reconstruction, concrete box culverts procurement and Installation, corrugated metal pipe procurement and installations, tile investigation, removal, and installation and seeding, mulching and fertilizing. The engineer's opinion of probable cost for all four projects is approximately \$460,000 for all four projects.
